My Afterschool DC (MADC) is a new initiative stemming from Mayor Bowser's goal of Afterschool for All. The vision for MADC is for all children, youth, and families across the District of Columbia to have knowledge of and access to an increased number of high-quality OST programs through the MADC portal. The Parent Advisory Group will consist of DC parents who will serve as "internal testers" for the MADC portal.
